What is The Carpenter's Table?	A community food pantry.
Where is The Carpenter's Table located?	5957 Reidville Rd., Moore, S.C.
When is The Carpenter's Table open?	Saturdays from 8 a.m. – noon.
How many families are served each week?	Between 100 and 200 families.
What should I wear when serving at TCT?	Wear clothing and shoes appropriate for the weather on the day you will be serving. Keep in mind that you may be serving outdoors.
When should I arrive?	Arrive 10 minutes before your scheduled time.
Where should I park?	Next door in Tyger River Presbyterian Church's parking lot.
What will I do when volunteering at TCT?	You will be helping with food distribution in a variety of ways: client sign-in, shopping for clients (runner), pre-bagging fruits and vegetables, or writing dates on donated food items.
What should I do upon arrival?	Come inside, write your name and email address in the volunteer log book, put on a name tag, and check in with the coordinator.
Can I bring my child with me to serve?	Children in second grade through middle school may serve alongside a parent. High schoolers can volunteer without a parent.
Are clients allowed in the building?	Clients should not enter the building without a volunteer.
Can I take photos of or pray with clients?	Always ask permission before taking a client's picture or praying with a client.
